



About Pathways

In order to carry a positive action one must develop a positive vision, with one such vision Sahyadri College shared its campus to the new program called The Pathways.Pathways is the program originally sponsored by Ford foundation of US in the year 2002-2003 as a part of global project. In India, it was initiated through Foundation for Academic Excellence and Access (FAEA).

The main goal of Pathways is to provide a global outlook with regional focus, commitment to equality and social justice, and to develop the holistic view to students from the marginalized sections of society. The financial support from Ford stopped in the year 2009. But realizing benefits of program, Kuvempu University took decisions to continue the activity with its own budgetary provision. In order to provide life skills and empower the students to become self dependent role models of the country.

Selection of students to the Pathways is done on basis of class 12th marks and performance in entrance test conducted at the first year of the degree level. Forty five students are selected every year from arts, commerce, and science streams and trained continuously for 3 year till they complete their degrees. The training goes along side the regular course. This includes Afternoon daily club activities, Saturdays Expert's session, Ten days winter and summer workshops, IAS/KAS and Competitive Exams Workshop, Field Visits, Mini-workshops, Celebration of National Days,.. Etc.

The primary aim to understand the interconnections exist between professionalism and knowledge systems. In order to achieve these objectives, various theme-based talks by experts, academics and professional experts and students' projects and programs are conducted during the workshops. Moreover, the core focus of this workshops are intended to trigger multiple aptitudes among students towards multidisciplinary approaches.

Each student is provided an opportunity to demonstrate her/his talent in numerous ways at one hand. On the other hand, student participants are expected to inculcate qualities like; focus, leadership, and action to implement the objectives of pathways in general and the workshop in particular. However, the volunteers of pathways are from different streams of bachelor degrees (i.e. B.A, BSc and B.com) of Sahyadri Science, Arts and Commerce colleges. This particular composition of students always possess challenges in conducting programs on a single theme or topic. Therefore we in pathways conduct activities related to various disciplines to accomplish the aspirations of our students.

Pathways handpicks the resource persons from different walks of life like academics, Science and technology, spiritualism, art and culture etc. They share their vision and experience with the young students. The present academic calendar in the higher educational institutions hardly provides time for non-academic learning, which


Program: One day Workshop on banking exams.

Program: A virtual session on 'The Science Behind Sounding Rocket'.

The session was facilitated by **Mr. Ankit Chaudhary**, Head Operating Officer, TeamSpacital. The session was based on "Rocket Design: Parameters & Constraints and Rocket: Aerodynamic and Trajectory" where our speaker addressed the designing constraint of Rocket and types of propellants.

Rocket is a vehicle that launches into the space and the structural designing helps it to gain the thrust to permeate through gravitational pull. He explained that the external design is crucial to overall weight, strength and stiffness of rocket. As the rocket need to be lightweight, strong and stiff in the bending; Carbon fiber reinforcement polymer(CFRP), Aluminium, PVC (polyvinyl chloride) and Fiberglass are used in making.

In Aerodynamic & Trajectory, as the term indicates, was mainly about launch, flight and descend of the rocket. He stressed about the three parameters to be kept in note: 1) The Object, 2) The Motion 3) The Air for a successful rocket launch. He said that shape of an object has a very great effect on the amount of drag and the drag increases with increased area. He summarized the topic with the relationship between 'moving fluid' (air) and 'center of pressure' and center of mass, force acting on rocket with respect to thrust and movable fins which helps in successful take-off of a rocket.

.Overall the session was informative and enlightening.







On 05/09/2021, the second and final day of mini workshop on "Psychometric analysis" was facilitated by Prof.Divakar Rao.



Prof. K B Dhananjay, spoke some inspiring words.




Prof. H M Vagdevi, Principal, Sahyadri Science College; Chief Functionary, Pathways Training and Placement Cell gave presidential address.


Program: Kannada Rajyotsava Celebration.

About Pathways.....

The main goal of Pathways is to provide a global outlook with regional focus, commitment to equality and social justice, and to develop the holistic view to students from the marginalized sections of society. The financial support from Ford stopped in the year 2009. But realizing benefits of programme, Kuvempu University took decisions to continue the activity with its own budgetary provision. In order to provide life skills and empower the students to become self-dependent role models of the country.

Selection of students to the Pathways is done on basis of class 12th marks and performance in entrance test conducted at the first year of the degree level. Forty five students are selected every year from arts, commerce, and science streams and trained continuously for 3 year till they complete their degrees. The training goes alongside the regular course. This includes Afternoon daily club activities, Saturdays Expert's session, Ten days winter and summer workshops, IAS/KAS and Competitive Exams Workshop, Field Visits, Mini-workshops, Celebration of National Days,.. etc.

conduct activities related to various disciplines to accomplish the aspirations of our students.

Pathways is the program originally sponsored by Ford foundation of US in the year 2002-2003 as a part of global project. In India, it was initiated through Foundation for Academic Excellence and Access (FAEA).


Program: "Election Awareness"

On 1st June 2024, Pathways Training and Placement Cell organized a Saturday session on the topic Sustainable Organic Farming For Livelihood facilitated by Dr. N S MAVARKAR DEAN College of Horticulture Mudigere, Chikmagaluru. Session commenced with a discussion on the percentage of agricultural land and its impacts on Indian agriculture, including insights on the Green Revolution, conservation efforts and challenges in modern farming. Despite a growing population, there's a decreasing agricultural land in India. He emphasized the importance of organic practices for soil fertility. Resource person showcased some successful organic crop examples but cautioned against an immediate full shift to organic farming to avoid reduced productivity. Instead, he recommended integrated farming to maintain productivity and soil health, gradually increasing organic practices.



Regarding competitive exams, he provided statistics indicating that they typically consist of 50% Humanities (HEGP), 30% Science (PCB) and 20% Current Affairs., he recommended key publications such as TMH and UQ, among others, to avoid confusion when selecting study materials for competitive exams. The session underscored the critical importance of early career path planning.
