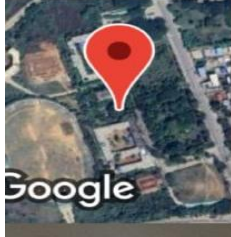
Dr. Veena S, Associate Professor, Pathology, Medical officer, McGann hospital, Shivamogga delivered a special talk on Blood Donation and its importance.

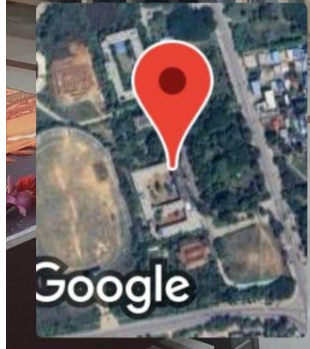

Blood donation camp was started exactly at 9.30AM and was continued until 2 PM. The entire blood donation programme was carried out under the supervision of group medical officials from McGann hospital, Shivamogga. The event started with Ganesha vandana. The programme was inaugurated by Dr. Sridhar S. Medical Superintendent, McGann hospital, Shivamogga and Alumni of the Sahyadri Science College.
